The Queensland Bulk Water Transport Authority, trading as LinkWater, is a Queensland Government Statutory Authority. LinkWater is responsible for the management, operation and maintenance of potable bulk water pipelines and related infrastructure throughout South East Queensland (SEQ).

It is LinkWater's obligation to pursue the highest possible standards for Work, Health and Safety (WHS) management in all our operations.

We are committed to conducting our business in a manner that prevents injury or illness to employees, contractors, customers and the public who may be affected by our work activities.

LinkWater will encourage best practice in WHS, while maintaining the highest level of quality workmanship through strategies that include:

- compliance with AS4801:2001 and all relevant statutory requirements, and making adequate provision of resources to meet those requirements
- developing a suite of internal WHS standards that provide the framework upon which LinkWater and our contractors will base the WHS Management System and associated implementation

- establishing key performance indicators in the WHS standards through which performance of the WHS Management System and implementation tools can be assessed
- developing and implementing comprehensive WHS information, training, behavioural and supervisory programs for all LinkWater and contractor personnel, ensuring they have the systems and tools they need to perform their activities safely
- defining WHS responsibilities and accountabilities for all persons within LinkWater and for our contractors
- joint consultation and participation between management and employees in planning, design and implementation stages for all workplace or process changes. This will promote and maintain safe and healthy conditions based on the principle that all incidents can be prevented.

The continual improvement of WHS performance requires the input and commitment of everyone working together as a team, sharing a fundamental duty of care to ourselves and others and sharing the commitment to achieve this goal.
